


AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON CERTAIN AREAS OF PROPERTY IN RESIDENTIAL ZONES IN THE CITY OF ROGERS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

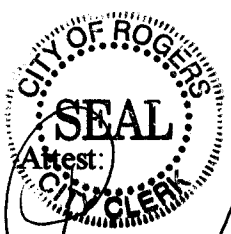
Section 1: Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a law enforcement officer or traffic-control device, or parking-control device, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, or permit a vehicle registered in his name to be stopped, standing or parked, on the grass in a yard between the residence and the street right of way in any residential zone in the City of Rogers. In addition, no person shall pave or gravel a yard to the extent that such paving or graveling violates the minimum open space requirement of the zoning ordinance for the zone in which the residence is located.


Section 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect September 1, 2007.
