PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to provide standardized company assignments for firefighters responding to first-alarm structure fires.

POLICY

Although ultimate responsibility for on scene tactical assignments rests with the City Wide Tour Commander, the institution of standard fire ground orders will assist with equipment and task responsibilities. Company officers and Incident Commanders may deviate from these standing orders upon direct order or when circumstances dictate alternative actions. Firefighters should understand that it is impossible for these standing fire ground orders to address all the needs and required actions on the incident scene. Rather this serves as a blueprint for anticipated and standard actions that regularly have to be addressed at incidents of the nature described below.

House Fire, First Alarm

Assignment: 2 Engines, 1 Truck, 1 Medic, 1 Chief

1st-In Engine Company

Driver – Pump Operator / Water Supply
Company Officer – FIRE ATTACK with tool
Firefighter – FIRE ATTACK

Truck Company

Driver – Setup aerial device and prepare for water supply, Bring PPV to front door
Company Officer – SEARCH AND RESCUE or VENTILATION GROUP
Firefighter – SEARCH AND RESCUE or VENTILATION GROUP
****Truck Company should bring thermal imaging camera****

2nd-In Engine Company

Driver – Assist with Water Supply, then OVERHAUL
Company Officer – Await partner, then stretch second line or assume OVERHAUL
Firefighter – Hydrant Operator, then OVERHAUL
****If performing overhaul, the 2nd-in Engine Co. should always bring a pike pole and attic ladder****

Medic Unit

Firefighter – Don PPE, Establish RIT Group – obtain RIT bag
FF/Paramedic – Don PPE, Establish RIT Group - bring EMS supplies

Command Unit

Battalion Chief – Operate and manage ICS and Safety Functions

**Commercial, Industrial, Multi-Family Residential, First Alarm
Assignment: 3 Engines, 1 Truck, 1 Medic, 1 Chief**

1st-In Engine Company

Driver – Pump Operator / Water Supply

Company Officer – FIRE ATTACK with tool

Firefighter – FIRE ATTACK

****The pump operator should dry stretch to the FDC if possible, if not the IC should be notified and the pump operator of the third-in engine company should prepare the stretch****

Truck Company

Driver – Setup aerial device and prepare for water supply

Company Officer – SEARCH AND RESCUE or VENTILATION GROUP

Firefighter – SEARCH AND RESCUE or VENTILATION GROUP

****Truck Company should bring thermal imaging camera****

2nd-In Engine Company

Driver – Assist with Water Supply, then OVERHAUL

Company Officer – Await partner, then stretch second line or assume OVERHAUL

Firefighter – Hydrant Operator, then OVERHAUL

****If performing overhaul, the 2nd-in Engine Co. should always bring a pike pole and attic ladder****

3rd-In Engine Company

Driver – Don PPE/SCBA, prepare to be assigned to an EXPOSURE or DIVISION

Company Officer – Prepare to be assigned to an EXPOSURE or DIVISION

Firefighter – Prepare to be assigned to an EXPOSURE or DIVISION

Medic Unit

Firefighter – Don PPE, Establish RIT Group – obtain RIT bag

FF/Paramedic – Don PPE, Establish RIT Group - bring EMS supplies

Command Unit

Battalion Chief – Operate and manage ICS and Safety Functions
